

A National Voice Ambassador Role

We are recruiting volunteers from around the country, who are in, or leaving care, to be Ambassadors for A National Voice. They will work together on project that will challenge the stereotypes about young people in care and get their voices heard around the country.

As an Ambassador for A National Voice, you will help to raise awareness and make life in care better for everyone. As part of a team of around 15 others, you will meet once a month to work on a project that tackles a particular problem around being in care.

You will decide the theme for the project at our first meeting.

You will...

- ◆ Raise awareness and challenge stigma about being in care
- ◆ Work creatively with other young people
- ◆ Use your knowledge, skills and experience to make a positive difference for children in care
- ◆ Attend training in relevant skills

We will provide...

- ◆ All expenses related to the project, including travel
- ◆ Professional training
- ◆ Opportunities for paid work at Coram Voice and Coram in the future
- ◆ A professional reference and interesting experience to add to your CV
- ◆ Support to develop a project in the way you decide, for example access to film makers, art spaces or opportunities to train professionals

You need to...

- ◆ Be between 16 and 25 years old
- ◆ Have experience of being in care
- ◆ Really want to raise awareness and challenge stigma about being in care
