Over the past year it has become ever more important to focus on children & young people's well-being. The Bright Spots Programme has supported over 50 local authorities to understand what makes life good for their children in care & care leavers through the '**Your Life, Your Care**' (children in care aged 4-18) and '**Your Life Beyond Care**' (care leavers aged 16-25) surveys & have gathered the views of over 14,000 children and young people to date.

Helping you improve your service

- We help you systematically listen to your children in care & care leavers about the things that are important to them so that this can **influence your service development** & strategic thinking, a key requisite of Ofsted.
- We work with you to tailor the survey distribution & ensure you achieve the **best possible response rates**.
- We carry out independent analysis & create **high quality reports**, that compare children & young people's responses in your local authority each year & **benchmark** against other local authorities. We highlight where you are doing well (Bright Spots) & areas for improvement.
- We **share learning** & innovative practice between local authorities involved in the programme.

What makes our surveys unique?

- The **largest surveys** of their kind allowing you to **compare** your children and young people's **subjective well-being** to other local authorities & to the general population.
- **Co-produced with children & young people** – the surveys are based on what 170 children in care & care leavers said was important to them.
- **Strongly evidence based** – the surveys are a robust research tool, developed over 7 years together with the University of Oxford, drawing on international research reviews, focus groups & rigorous piloting.
- **Quick & easy** to use online surveys with **confidential & secure** data handling.
- Captures the views of children as young as **4** & young people up to **25**.
